 you great sea creatures and all deeps,





8 fire and hail, snow and mist,

- ❖ Print the Psalm, Verses, & Prayers pages for everyone, so everyone can read & pray together.
- ❖ You do not need to print the Hymns & Songs and Helps pages for everyone.
- ❖ You can put everyone's printed pages in a sheet protector, or even laminate them, to help them hold up throughout the month.
- ❖ Pull up videos on YouTube before beginning, if you are using them, to avoid ads You can make a playlist for the month, if that is easier. Links & QR codes are available to pull up videos quickly.
 - We might listen to the YouTube video on the first day, if necessary, and sing acapella the rest of the days.
 - Sometimes, I learn the song acapella ahead of time, if we don't already know it, so we don't have to bring up the video during our Family Worship time.
- ❖ Decide how to rotate through Scriptures and Hymns & Songs each month.
 - Option 1: Choose one passage from Scriptures and one song from Hymns & Songs each week. Repeat those each day of Family Worship that week.
 - Option 2: Rotate through all of the passages from Scriptures and all of the songs from Hymns & Songs each week.
 - If you choose Option 1, here is an idea for months with a fifth week: Choose a favorite hymn from church or repeat a song from earlier in the month.

- ❖ In addition to the passages in the Scriptures section, be reading through the Bible together as a family. You can do this with a story Bible for young children. You can do this reading at a separate time.
- ❖ When you are finished with this month's Scripture passages, write them on a notecard, or put them in a binder, to save them. Review two or three per week at dinner time to keep them fresh.
